I am not going to pretend to have any of the answers as to the results from last weekend. There is no doubt that Friday night was a disappointing effort and result in their 5-3 empty net loss after giving up 2 power play goals within 30 seconds late in the game. Saturday, our team played much better and with more effort – after being significantly challenged by the staff - but had a major meltdown giving up four goals in the 2nd period before battling back to force overtime. Huge kudos to Kale Witt who entered the goal in relief in the 2nd period and gave our team a chance to win.

There are a lot of different dynamics that are prevalent during any hockey season that may have an impact on results. Consistency has been an issue with this team all season (see 2nd period Saturday) and the ability to play a full 60-minutes every night. Yes, this past weekend hurt and has made it more difficult to achieve our regular season goals – home ice for the playoffs, maximizing top prospect participation, taking care of business at home, etc. etc. – but it has not changed what this team can accomplish come March and now is the time to get laser focused and put in the work for the final 12 regular season games. Stay tuned as we will find out just how good this squad can be or maybe find out that we never were really as good as we thought. My gut says the former is the result!
